Grade categories

Finalists will be chosen from each grade, K-12.

Judging and Winners

All finalists' artwork will be featured on the Culver City Walk & Rollers website. 13 finalists will receive: a plaque of recognition and goody bag of prizes. Artwork Theme

The theme for the 2018 Culver City Walk & Rollers Safe Routes to School Art Competition is

"Why drive, when you can ...?"

Nearly 30% of our students are driven to school every day. This not only adds to the traffic and pollution around schools, but kids miss out on opportunities to learn about traffic safety, community awareness and responsibility.

We think there are better ways to get to school. Create an original piece of art depicting a better way to school and/or the benefits of not driving to school.

Media and Technique Requirements

Any of the following media or techniques may be used: Paint (watercolor, tempera, poster, acrylic, etc.); Drawing materials (pencil, charcoal, colored chalk, pastels, oil pastels, colored pencils, markers, etc.); Collage materials (cut and glued papers, such as construction paper, tissue paper, wrapping paper, aluminum foil, etc.); Prints (handmade stencils, gadget printing, collographs, block prints, etc.); Original digital illustration; Photography; Video.

Judging Criteria

A selection committee will review artwork submissions based on the following criteria: Interpretation of the theme, Technical skill and Originality

Copyright Law

Any artwork that depicts copyrighted images will be rejected. For example, no artworks depicting characters from television shows, movies, video games, or books will be accepted

SUBMISSION OF ARTWORK

Completed entry form must accompany each submission. One entry per student. Maximum size of original art: 24" x 36". Submit only original artwork that has been created by you, the artist, as identified on the submission form; no part of any artistic rendering that is submitted can be copied or adapted from another source. Paper entries must be mounted on mount board and all entries must be ready to hang. Photos and video must have been taken by the contestant during the past year (April 9, 2017-April 9, 2018). Videos must be submitted via flash drive or DVD. All artworks will be returned after the the exhiit closes.
